

## Proposed Bylaw Changes for 2022

### Article IV

#### Officers

Section 1: The officers of DRAW shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Points Keeper.

#### Proposed change:

Add the Past President to the Board, at least in an advisory position, so a new board has a reference person.

Section 4: The Vice-President shall, in the absence or disability of the President, or in the event of a vacancy in the office of the President, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President; and oversee and audit the records of the appointed secretary/treasurer.

Proposed change: Change the wording in duties of the Vice President where it says “and oversee and audit the records of the appointed secretary/treasurer” to “and oversee and audit records of the elected treasurer” because we divided the secretary/treasurer position and it is an elected position.

Also add, “The Vice-President shall be in charge of ordering all ribbons and getting them to the ride managers. He/she shall also be in charge of the Colorama 100 buckles and getting them to the Colorama ride.”

We have no listed rules as we follow UMECRA rules. However, in 2013, we passed the idea that all participants in a DRAW ride must wear a helmet. I propose that we establish a rule stating all participants in a DRAW ride must wear a helmet.

### Article VI

#### Year End Awards and Points

Section 6: To be eligible for year-end awards, a three (3) ride minimum is required.

#### Proposed change:

To be eligible for year-end awards, a minimum of three (3) ride completions is required. Current points on the website will reflect the number of completed rides only.

The last part is due to our current points on the website showing number of ride starts, which is very misleading.

Section 8: Versatility Award consists of the same horse and rider combination competing in Endurance, LD, and Competitive competitions and gaining the most points. Two rides of each category must be ridden to qualify. In the event of a tie, the horse and rider combination with the most miles will win the award. There will be two divisions awarded, Junior and Senior.

Proposed change: Versatility Award consists of the same horse and rider combination competing in Endurance, LD, and Competitive competitions and gaining the most points. Two rides of each category must be ridden **with completions** to qualify. In the event of a tie, the horse and rider combination with the most miles will win the award. There will be two divisions awarded, Junior and Senior.
